WATERING INSTRUCTIONS

- All trees and shrubs should be watered as soon as possible after planting and should be watered until the soil is completely saturated.
- Soak all plants three times a week for the first month. See watering table.
- After the first month of watering, water at least once a week for the duration of the growing season.
- It is better to water infrequently with large amounts of water than to water frequently with small amounts.
- A good watering method is to use a garden hose with the water running at a slow trickle.
- Always water during any dry spells.
- Water all plants in late fall before ground freezes.
- Different types of soil will retain different amounts of moisture. To check moisture content use touch of fingers six inches below soil surface.
