Darrow	5	3'	1 qt.	July	Fruit is firm, juicy, and has a honey sweet flavor. Excellent for all purposes. Continues to ripen for 2-3 weeks.
BLUEBERRY					
Blue crop	4	4-6'	10-20 lbs	Early Aug.	Large fruit. Firm berries. Upright habit 4-6 ft. Recommended for ornamental use, fiery red in fall.
Chandler	4	4-5'	2 lbs	July	Very large berries producing up to 6 weeks. Excellent flavor. Self pollinating.
Chippewa	4	4-5'	3-8 lbs	July	Sweet berry flavor. Medium sized fruit. Red fall color.
